

## Hebrews 1:2, Bible Devotions

### ☐ Monday - Christ the Heir of all things. Hebrews 1:2

Our text today declares that God the Father has appointed His Son *heir of all things* (Heb. 1:2). Elsewhere we read, “For by Him [Christ] *all things* were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—*all things* have been created through Him and for Him” (Col. 1:16). O Lord, “The heavens are Yours, the earth also is Yours; the world and all it contains” (Psa. 89:11). Yes, to Christ “belongs the glory and dominion forever and ever” (1 Pet. 4:11).  
Read Ephesians 1:20-22, Philipians 2:1-11

### ☐ Tuesday - Coheirs with Christ. Hebrews 1:2

“The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ” (Rom. 8:16-17). “In Him [Christ] we have obtained an *inheritance* ... and “In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise, who is given as a pledge of our *inheritance*” (Eph. 1:10-14). Christian, “give thanks to the Father, who has qualified us to share in the *inheritance* of the saints” (Col. 1:12).  
Read Matthew 5:5

### ☐ Wednesday - An Inconceivable Inheritance. Hebrews 1:2

The apostle Peter writes, “Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to obtain an *inheritance* which is imperishable and undefiled and will not fade away, reserved in heaven for you” (1 Pet. 1:3-4). Concerning the nature of that inheritance, the apostle Paul writes, “No eye has seen, no ear has heard, what no human mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him” (1 Cor. 2:9).  
Read Ephesians 2:4-7

### ☐ Thursday - We Will be Like Him. Hebrews 1:2

Perhaps the greatest aspect of the Christian’s inheritance is eternal fellowship with our all-glorious Savior in new glorified bodies! “Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, *we will be like Him*, because we will see Him just as He is” (1 John 3:2). We will never be little gods, but to the degree that finite beings can share in Christ’s glory we will be like Him. And that glorified body will be incorruptible (i.e. unable to sin), glorious, spiritual, and immortal.  
Read 1 Cor. 15:42-53, 2 Cor. 3:18, Phil. 3:20-21

### ☐ Friday - Identifying with Christ’s Suffering. Hebrews 1:2

“The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God, if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we *suffer* with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him” (Rom. 8:16-17). To live for Jesus Christ in this fallen world is not easy. “Indeed, all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted” (2 Tim. 3:12). But compared to the eternal inheritance that awaits God’s people, the apostle Paul writes, “I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed to us” (Rom. 8:18). And again he writes, “Momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison (2 Cor. 4:17). So hang on, Christian! “To the degree that you share the sufferings of Christ, keep on rejoicing, so that also at the revelation of His glory you may rejoice with exultation” (1 Pet. 4:13). The best is yet to come!
