1. Pattern of Psalm 25. 1-22

- Acrostic: 22 verses begin with 22 letters of Hebrew alphabet.
- First of 7 alphabetic psalms: 24, 34, 37, 111, 112, 119, 145

2. Principles of Prayer. 1-3

- “I trust” v. 2
- “I wait” v. 3, 5, 21
- Arguments. v. 6-7

3. Paths of Righteousness. 4-5

- “Make me know Your ways, O Lord; teach me Your paths.” v. 4
- “He instructs sinners in the way.” v. 8
- “He leads the humble in justice, and He teaches the humble His way.” v. 9
- “All the paths of the Lord are lovingkindness and truth” v. 10

4. Pardon for Sin. 6-11

- “Do not remember the sins of my youth” v. 7
- “Pardon my iniquity, for it is great” v. 11

5. Proper Fear of God. 12-15

- “Who is the man who fears the Lord? He will instruct him in the way he should choose.” v. 12
- “The secret of the Lord is for those who fear Him” v. 14

6. Protection from Enemies. 16-22

- “I am lonely and afflicted” v. 16
- “The troubles of my heart are enlarged” v. 17
- “Look upon my affliction... Look upon my enemies.” v. 18
