1. Song of the Saints. v. 1-5

- *“Praise the Lord! Sing to the Lord a new song, and His praise in the congregation of the godly ones.”* (v. 1)
- *“Let Israel be glad in his Maker; let the sons of Zion rejoice in their King.”* (v. 2)
- *“Let them praise His name with dancing; let them sing praises to Him with timbrel and lyre.”* (v. 3)
- *“For the Lord takes pleasure in His people; He will beautify the humble with salvation.”* (v. 4)
- *“Let the godly ones exult in glory; let them sing for joy on their beds.”* (v. 5)

2. Sword of the Spirit. v. 6-9

- *“Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand”* (v. 6)
- *“To execute vengeance on the nations and punishment on the peoples”* (v. 7)
- *“To bind their kings with chains and their nobles with fetters of iron”* (v. 8)
- *“To execute on them the judgment written; this is an honor for all His godly ones. Praise the Lord!”* (v. 9)
